Early lights out and rising times allow for the guests to get plenty of rest for the active, full days. Great for families!

Owned by the Schooner Martha Foundation and **built in 1907** at the famous W.F. Stone Boat Yard in San Francisco, Martha is an **84-foot B.B. Crowninshield staysail schooner** fully equipped for cruising Northwest waters.
